ADMISSION NON-RESIDENT AND TUITION
STUDENTS INTRA-SCHOOL CONTRACT

_____, the “sending district” and “receiving district”, in consideration of the mutual coverage set forth below agree as follows:

1. Both districts enter into this contract pursuant to the provision of Wyoming Statute 21-4-505 (as amended 1999).
2. The sending school agrees that the student, _____ is a resident of the sending district and is not currently under suspension or expulsion for violation of weapons related rules, regulations or laws.
3. This contract is for a term of one year, from July 1, 20___, to June 30, 20___. This contract may be terminated by either party at any time, by written notice to the other party.
4. Sending district shall not be required to pay tuition to receiving district for the enrollment of _____ in the school of receiving district, except as set forth herein for special education students.
5. Receiving district reserves the right to refuse to enroll any and all students and to remove students who have been enrolled. Sending district reserves the right to remove any and all students who have been enrolled by receiving district.
6. Tuition for special education students will be negotiated on a case-by-case basis. Receiving district shall provide the same services for special education students from sending district as are available for its own resident special education students attending schools in receiving district. However, if receiving district incurs expenses and costs for any special education student from sending district that are in addition to the usual and ordinary expenses and costs of receiving district for its own resident special education students attending schools within the receiving district, then sending district shall pay receiving district the total amount of additional expense and cost incurred by receiving district for that special education student.
7. Receiving district shall provide its regular curriculum for students from sending district and will allow these students equal access to all services, including restricted enrollment classes, as are available to resident students of receiving district.

8. Transportation costs are not covered under this contract. It is responsibility of sending district to provide necessary transportation or make arrangements for such transportation.

9. Students from sending district may participate in all extra curricular activities available to resident students, unless prohibited by the rules and regulations of the Wyoming High School Activities Association or other similar group or entity with authority to govern participation in extra-curricular activities.
