**STUDENTS, CERTIFIED/NON-CERTIFIED STAFF**

**CORPORAL PUNISHMENT**

No teacher, administrator, student or other person will subject a student to corporal punishment or condone the use of corporal punishment by any person under his or her supervision or control. Permission to administer corporal punishment will not be sought or accepted from any parent, guardian or school official.

Corporal punishment is defined as the intentional use of physical force upon any student for any alleged offense or behavior or the use of physical force in an attempt to modify the behavior, thoughts or attitudes of a student.

This policy is not intended to prohibit reasonable physical restraint of a student who is uncontrollable or poses a danger to himself or others. It is further not the intent of this policy to prohibit teachers or administrators from taking appropriate physical action in self-defense.
