POLICY

CLASS RANK RECOGNITION

Upton High School will recognize graduating seniors having achieved class rank as follows:

Class rank computation based on grade point average in required courses for students enrolled as members of the senior class at the end of the first semester. Students must be enrolled for a minimum of two (2) semesters.

The senior student having the highest grade point average in required courses, based on seven (7) semesters of achievement will be recognized as the class valedictorian. The senior student having the second highest grade point average in required courses, based on seven (7) semesters of achievement will be recognized as the class salutatorian.

In the event of a tie for valedictorian/salutatorian designation, the ACT score will be multiplied by .01 and added to the GPA.

If a tie still exists for the valedictorian designation there will be multiple valedictorian designations and no salutatorian designation.

All students that obtain a 3.66+ in required courses will graduate "With Honors".
